Barts and The Royal London Hospital is an accredited cancer centre in London. The centre provides the **full spectrum of care for women with gynaecological cancer**. This includes, out-patient, diagnostic, in patient, gynaecological oncology surgery, gynaecological precision medicine and cancer prevention service for high risk women, colposcopy, specialist vulval clinic, out-patient hysteroscopy services, MDT (tumour board) and integrated pathology, radiology, medical oncology and clinical oncology services. The centre provides **comprehensive training in the surgical management** of gynaecological malignancies, together with **non-surgical management** including medical oncology, radiotherapy, palliative care, cancer genetics and all other aspects of modular training mandated by the Royal College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists. **The centre is accredited for training** in gynaecological oncology by the **RCOG** (Royal College of Obstetrics and Gynaecologists) as well as **ESGO** (European Society of Gynaecological Oncology).

We invite applications for a **short term 6 months attachment** in the post of Sub-specialty **Trainee in gynaecological oncology, beginning in September/October 2019**. The fellow will work within a team comprising 5 gynaecological oncology surgeons (consultants), 2 fellows, and 6 junior O&G trainees, CNS (clinical nurse specialists). We are a research active department with a clinical trials team embedded in the clinical team. This is a **non-funded post**. It is important for this person/trainee to be quite experienced to be able to manage this role. The person needs to have **good command of spoken and written English**. It may suit someone **in the middle or at the end of sub-specialty training** who wants the experience of another international center. The person will need to have GMC registration and license to practice to work in the UK.

Short listed applicants will need to attend a face to face interview.
