○ Workshop overview:

The Colposcopy and Gynaecological Oncology Course is designed for both beginners and advanced practitioners to provide them with cutting-edge knowledge, hands-on skills, and the latest evidencebased updates in women's health.

*The course brings together participants from **BSCCP, Subspecialty Gynae-Oncology, leading experts in complex gynaecology procedures** to help you advance your clinical practice and gain confidence in managing complex cases.*

*Whether you are starting your journey in this specialty or aiming to refine your expertise, The program blends **expert-led lectures, interactive case discussions, patient communication training, and hands-on practical sessions**, ensuring participants not only master technical skills but also develop the art of patient-centred communication using the **Breaking Bad News approach**.*

- During full three days, more than 30 hours a strong focus on real-life practice, trainees will work through **+27 clinical cases (+15 Colposcopy cases and 12 Basic / Complex Gynae-Oncology theatre cases)** and more than 25 colposcopy cases using the PowerPoint slide shows, encountering and recognizing a wide spectrum of cervical abnormalities / precancerous lesions and gynaecological conditions.

○ **Workshop objectives & Who should attend:**

The course is designed for Gynaecologists (Consultants and Senior Trainees) with interest in Gynaecological Oncology & Colposcopy practice who aim to provide:

1. Prevention, Screening & Early Detection:

- *Understand the role of HPV in cervical carcinogenesis and current challenges in primary screening.*
- *Apply the recent updates from the NHS Cervical Screening Programme (2026).*
- *Develop skills in early detection of cervical lesions.*
- *Develop communication skills of the colposcopy clinic.*

2. Diagnostic Skills & Colposcopy:

- *Interpret diagnosis and outline the management of +15 colposcopic pathologies/lesions by PowerPoint slide shows.*
- *Identify and interpret:*
 - *Acetowhite acetic changes by PowerPoint slide shows and real cases.*
 - *Abnormal vascular patterns (punctuation & mosaicism) by PowerPoint slide shows.*
 - *Evaluation and grading of CIN (I–III) by PowerPoint slide shows.*
- *Gain hands-on experience in Speculum examination, Colposcopic technique and Liquid-Based Cytology (LBC) - Cervical smear on real cases.*
- *Perform accurate biopsy techniques (punch biopsy & LLETZ) by simulation sessions or/and real cases.*

3. Core Oncology Knowledge:

- *Review evidence-based updated management of:*
 - *Cervical cancer.*
 - *Endometrial cancer.*
 - *Ovarian cancer.*

- *Understand disease pathways, staging and management principles.*

4. Peri-operative Optimization:

- *Apply principles of pre-operative assessment and diagnostic techniques in gynaecologic oncology patients.*
- *Understand and implement Enhanced Recovery After Surgery (ERAS) protocols.*

5. Conservative & Fertility-Sparing Approaches:

- *Update knowledge on conservative management of CIN 1 & CIN 2. (M.H.) • Explore options for fertility preservation in cancer patients.*

6. Surgical Skills & Anatomical Understanding:

- *Observe and assist in live gynaecologic oncology surgeries.*
- *Understand key surgical anatomy relevant to types of hysterectomy.*

8. Integrated Practical Experience:

- *Engage in interactive stations and small group workshops.*
- *Integrate theoretical knowledge with real-time clinical practice.*

○ **Colposcopy simulation & live Hands-on:**

The simulation & hands-on session focusing on early screening and diagnostic techniques for cervical lesions will be atleast +15 cases over the three days (+5 cases every day). Participants will be divided into three groups with one group every day:

- *Practice of Liquid-Based Cytology (LBC).*
- *Techniques for cervical and paracervical nerve block.*
- *Diagnostic colposcopy, including:*
 - *Acetic acid test for acetowhite changes.*
 - *Cauterization of cervical ectropion.*
- *Punch biopsy techniques by simulation sessions or/and real cases.*
- *Introduction and demonstration of LLETZ procedures by simulation sessions or/and real cases.*

- *Gain a solid understanding of **colposcopy principles and clinical applications**.*
- *Accurately identify and interpret **cervical pathology and red flag findings**.*
- *Update their knowledge of **gynaecological cancer diagnosis and management**.*

- *Develop advanced communication skills using the **Breaking Bad News framework**.*
- *Experience hands-on training with **spot-diagnosis and simulating real practice of 74+ clinical cases**.*
