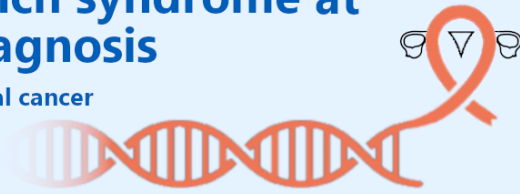


Genetic testing for Lynch syndrome at endometrial cancer diagnosis

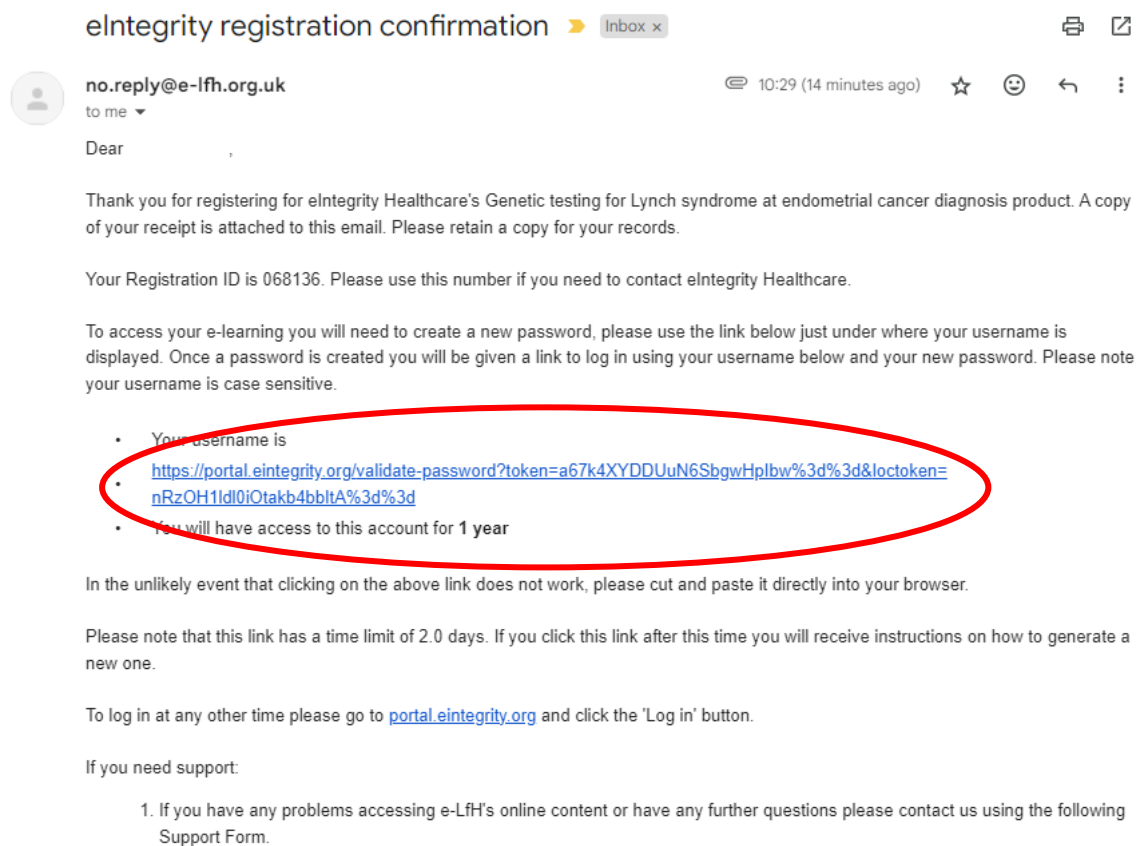

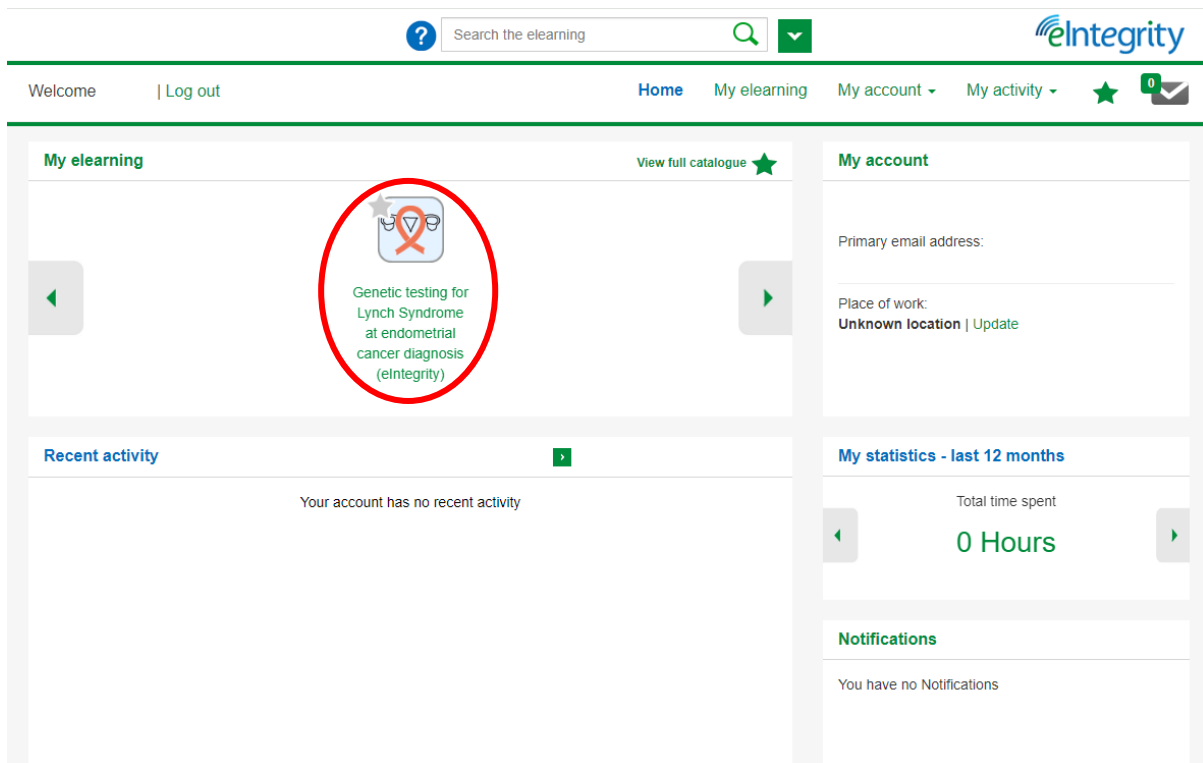

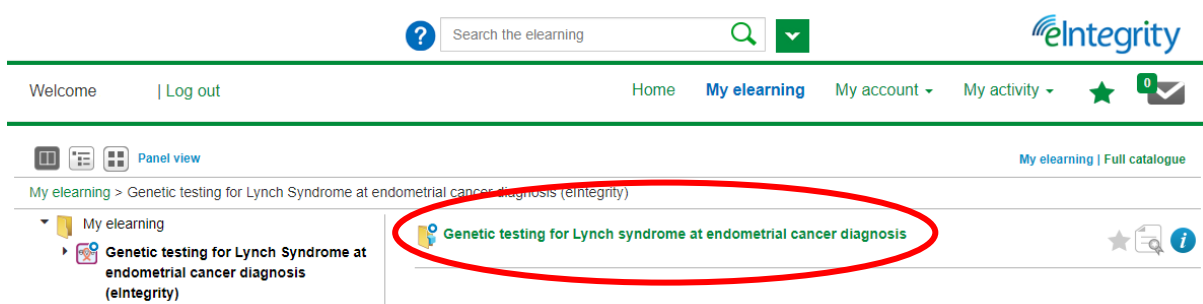
13. On the next page, confirm your personal details by clicking “Existing Details Correct”. If needed, you can edit the details and click on “Save changes”

14. On the next page in the login wizard, you have the option of checking your device to ensure it is set-up to display and record your elearning activity. You can do this by clicking on “Check my device”. If you perform this, click on the Continue button that appears. Alternatively, you can click on “Complete Registration”.
